2. Oil is one of the world's major sources of energy. We depend on it as fuel for heating, transport and the generation of power. For centuries, animal and vegetable oils have been used for cooking and as a source of artificial light. But it is mineral Oil

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which meets most of the world's needs today.

Crude Oil comes out of the earth as a thick brown or black liquid with a strong smell. It is a complex mixture of many different substances, each with its own different qualities. Most of them are combinations of hydrogen and carbon in varying proportions Such hydrocarbons are also found in other forms eg, in beitumen, asphalt and natural gas.

Mineral Oil originates from the carcasses of tiny creatures and from plants that live in the sea. Over million years, they form large deposits on the seabed, and ocean currents cover them with a blanket of sand and silt. As this material hardens, it becomes sedimentary rock and thus shuts out the oxygen. As a result, it prevents decomposition of the marin deposits underneath. The layers of sedimentary rock become thicker and thicker. Their pressure generates heat, which transforms the marine deposits into crude oil. This is a continuing process which is still going on today.
